The APICS Educational and Research (E&R) Foundation offers many opportunities for students to expand their résumés. APICS student members are eligible for the following E&R Foundation opportunities:

- **The Donald W. Fogarty International Student Paper Competition** recognizes excellence in research relevant to the field of production and inventory management. The competition is open to full- and part-time graduate and undergraduate students. Cash awards are given for the best papers submitted at the regional and national levels. - **The E&R Foundation** awards grants for new research. Grant proposals in the \$1,000 to \$5,000 range are reviewed biannually and are awarded to individual scholars and research teams. Special competitions may offer higher awards. For grant guidelines, ask for stock #01069.
- **The George and Marion Plossl Doctoral Dissertation Competition** presents awards to Ph.D. candidates for the best doctoral dissertation on an important integrated production and inventory management topic. For information or guidelines, request stock #04089.

- **The Research Paper Series** published by the E&R Foundation is a series of booklets on applied research topics such as supply chain management, reverse logistics, e-business, and collaborative commerce studies written by academicians and practitioners. These materials are particularly useful reference tools for students executing research assignments. Executive summaries are available on the Web site. - **Academic workshops and seminars** are available for students and faculty. Programs are designed to promote new research, introduce curriculum changes in production and operations management, and integrate business and engineering curricula. 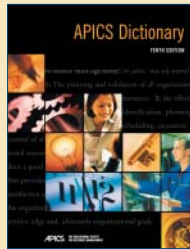

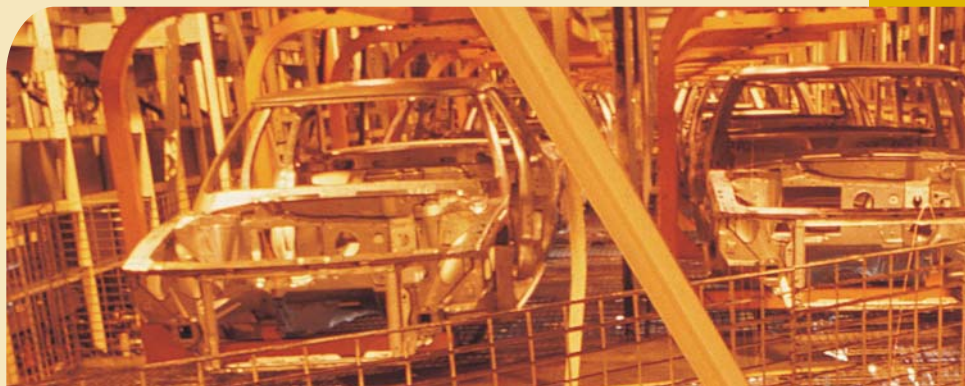

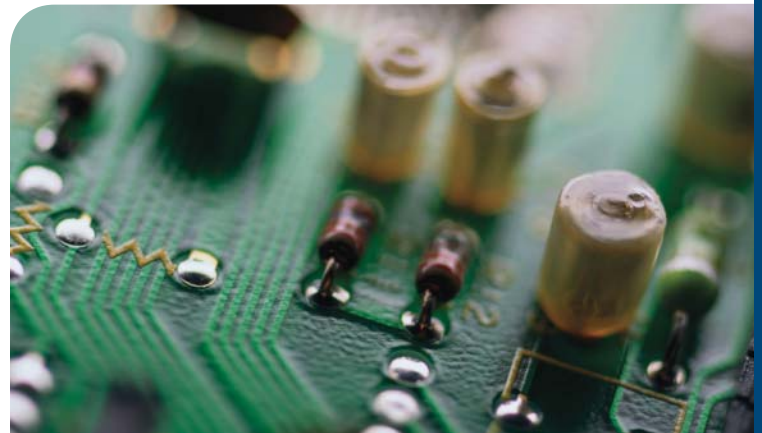
